Here are the salient points of "The 2018 Rotary Community Service Scholarship."

- The Glens Falls Rotary Club is offering two scholarships of up to \$2,500 each (the final awards may be less than \$2,500).
- Applicants must be seniors.
- Applicants must have at least a "B" average as confirmed by the respective Guidance Counselor on the attached template. PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT submit Guidance Counselor College Recommendation Letters.
- Applications and supporting materials must be received by no later than **Thursday, April 12, 2018.**
- Applicants must complete the Scholarship application and **send it via email** to: Karin Kilgore-Green, Scholarship Committee, at: [kgreen@jmzarchitects.com](mailto:kgreen@jmzarchitects.com). Applications can be obtained from the Glens Falls High School or Queensbury High School Guidance office. **Please do NOT submit completed applications to the Rotary web site.**
- Applicants must provide a brief letter of recommendation from an organization which benefited from the student's service, describing the impact of his or her involvement.
- Finalists may be asked to meet with a panel of Rotarians for a brief interview as part of the selection process.
- Winners will be announced in May and the awards will be presented at a Rotary Club luncheon meeting, date to be determined.
